

SNAKE EYES INSTRUCTIONS

For 2 or more players

Players take turns rolling two dice.

A turn consists of rolling the dice, adding the two dice together, and deciding whether to risk the total number of points earned on that roll.

If a player chooses to stop rolling and take the total of the two dice as a score, they write it on the score sheet.

If a player decides to risk the points earned from the first roll, they may roll again. However, if she rolls a 1, then she will lose the points accumulated in that turn, and her turn is over. If the player rolls two ones, then that player loses all the points accumulated in the game thus far and returns to a score of zero.

A player can roll as many times as she would like adding the total number of points as she goes as long as she does not roll any ones.

The first player to 100 wins the game!

Variation

Start with 100 and subtract the number of points rolled on the dice. The first person to get to 0 wins the game.
