

## **SPEED (or Spit) Card Game Instructions**

**(Great game for practicing counting forwards and backwards fluently)**

- Use a regular deck of cards (Ace - 10) or any number cards 1 - 10 (at least 4 of each).
- Evenly distribute the cards among two players.
- Place four cards face up in front of each player and a draw pile for each player.
- Begin by saying "spit" and turning over one card from each draw pile into the center of the playing area.
- Players use the cards that are face up in front of them to place on either center pile in ascending or descending order.
  - For example, cards could be placed on one of the piles like this: 1,2,3,4,3,2,3,4,5,6,5,4 etc.)
- Ones or aces can be placed on the 10 cards (optional).
- As players use the face up cards in front of them, they replace those cards from the draw pile so there are always four cards in front of them.
- When no plays can be made by either player, both players say "spit" and place another card on top of the center piles.
- The first person out of cards is the winner.
